
## SPECIAL ADVISOR TO THE MINISTER JELENA PAREZANOVIĆ



Mrs. Parezanović graduated in Scandinavian languages and literature from the University of Belgrade, Faculty of Philology, in 2007. She then completed a course at the London School of Public Relations, acquiring the necessary knowledge and skills in communicating with the public.
