
## Ivana Antić



From 2009 to 2012, Ms. Antić worked for the former Serbian European Integration Office. Her duties involved coordinating and drafting strategic documents for Serbia's accession to the European Union and preparing proposals of statutes on social policy and employment, free movement of workers, anti-discrimination policy, political and social-economic criteria, which required harmonisation with the acquis, assisting public administration organs in the process. She was also involved in bilateral and multilateral negotiations.

From 2012 to 2014, Ms. Antić served as an International Cooperation Advisor to the Deputy Prime-Minister and Minister of Labour, Employment and Social Policy. During 2014 and 2015, she assisted the Head of the Negotiating Team for the Accession of the Republic of Serbia to the European Union by overseeing matters pertaining to human and minority rights, social and economic rights, antidiscrimination and the National Minority Councils.

In 2015, Ms. Antić joined the Ministry of Public Administration and Local Self-Government to work as the Human and Minority Rights Special Advisor to the respective Minister and Deputy PrimeMinister. She performed the tasks of the Chief of Section for Human and Minority Rights and Registries until 9 February 2017 when she was appointed Acting Assistant Minister.

Ms. Antić was born in 1976 in Belgrade.
